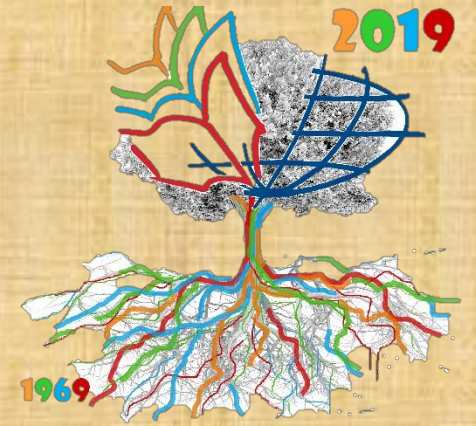

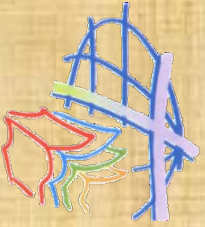

HISTORY

 Fruit of Vatican II
 Founded by initiative of the President of the Pontifical Council for Promoting Christian Unity, Cardinal Augustin Bea, and officially recognized by Pope Paul VI on 16 April 1969
 The General Secretariat was established in Rome in 1970, was transferred in 1972 to Stuttgart (Germany) and in 2006 to Sankt Ottilien (Germany) where it is currently located
 Currently membership comprises 101 Episcopal Conferences and 233 different Catholic institutions engaged in various forms of biblical pastoral ministry within the Catholic Church and a variety of ecumenical projects in 126 countries worldwide.

IDENTITY

 It is a global Catholic association of national and international organizations dedicated to biblical pastoral ministry.
 It relates to the Holy See through the Pontifical Council for Promoting Christian Unity, this being the competent ecclesiastical authority for the Federation.
 It is a non-profit association, legally registered in Germany.

MISSION

To promote and develop the Biblical Pastoral Ministry in such a way as to allow the Word of God as present in Sacred Scripture to become a dynamic source of inspiration for all areas of the life and mission of the Church in today's world, following the lines set forth in the Second Vatican Council's Dogmatic Constitution on Divine Revelation "Dei Verbum" and in the Post-Synodal Apostolic Exhortation "Verbum Domini", as well as in the documents of the Pontifical Biblical Commission, and in collaboration with the Bishops and the Bishops' Conferences (Const. 9.1)
